## INSURANCE - IMPORTANT NOTICE TO MEMBERS



On legal advice Council was advised there was exposure to risk for the Council & its Affiliates if an Off Shore Provider could not meet its Policy responsibilities. After much negotiation Council has put Insurance Policies in place with Broker Aon (for Lloyds Of London & Authorised in Australia) for Public Liability, Officers & Directors (Club cover) & Personal Accident – Voluntary Workers (Club cover) for period from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2004 to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2005.

This was undertaken at a Pro Rata Rate to make cost difference more manageable & bring Policies Expiry date to fit in better with the Financial year of the Council & Clubs. Member Fees will need to be increased prior to AGM's next year to keep up with the cost increase. As a benefit to its NSW Members the SHC has agreed on this occasion to absorb the difference between old rate \$8 & the Public Liability Pro Rata Rate of \$22.55 for the stated period. Constituent Affiliates will be charged at the new rate for its members.

Provisions include that Waivers are required to be completed by ALL members (All Events can be covered under Annual Waiver) & by riding Non -members. Helmet/Hard Hat Regulations apply as per S.H.C. Rules. Please complete the Waivers provided by your Club & return it as matter of urgency, the Council will require confirmation prior to competition.

The Council now has its Risk Management Policy in place, members & Clubs should make themselves aware of their responsibilities under the Policy. We must continue our good record in regard to Safety issues & thank you all for your co-operation in making this happen.
