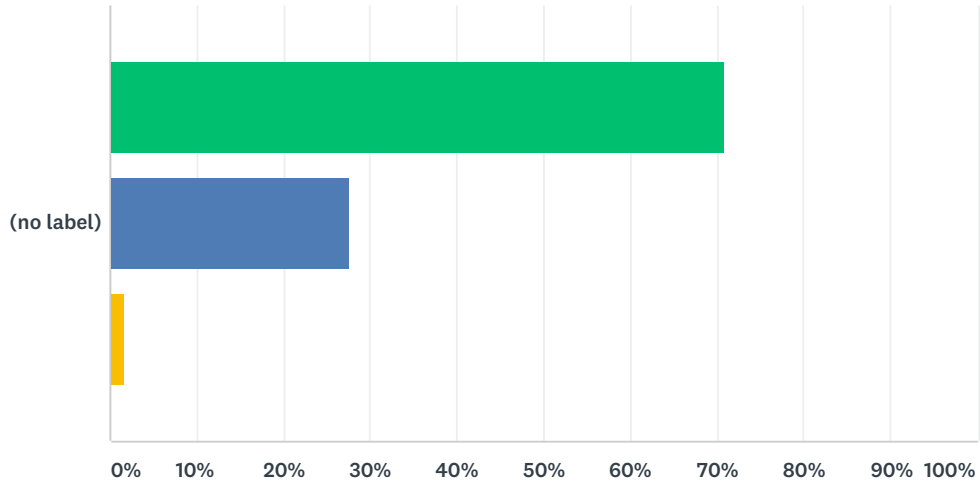


Q1 What is your SHC Membership Type?

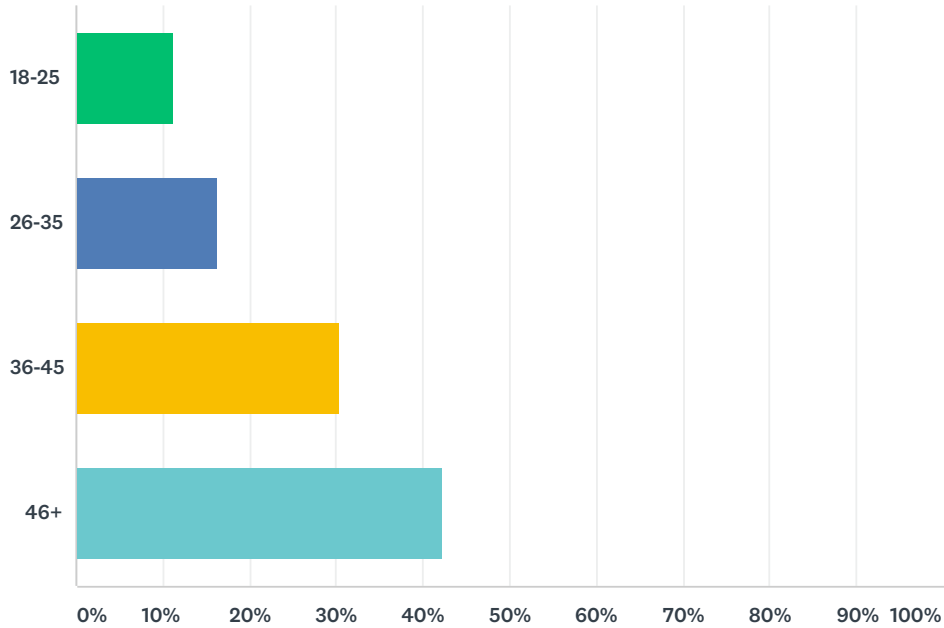

Q2 In which age group do you belong?

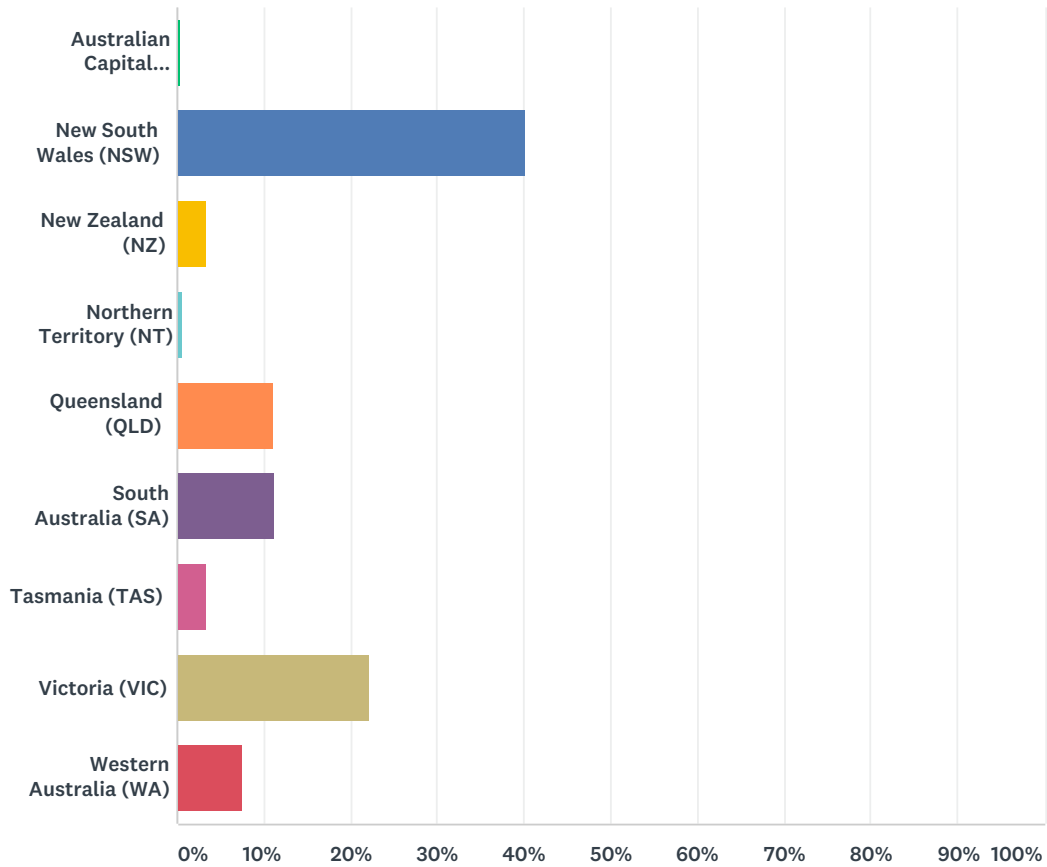

Q3 In which Country, State or Territory do you reside?

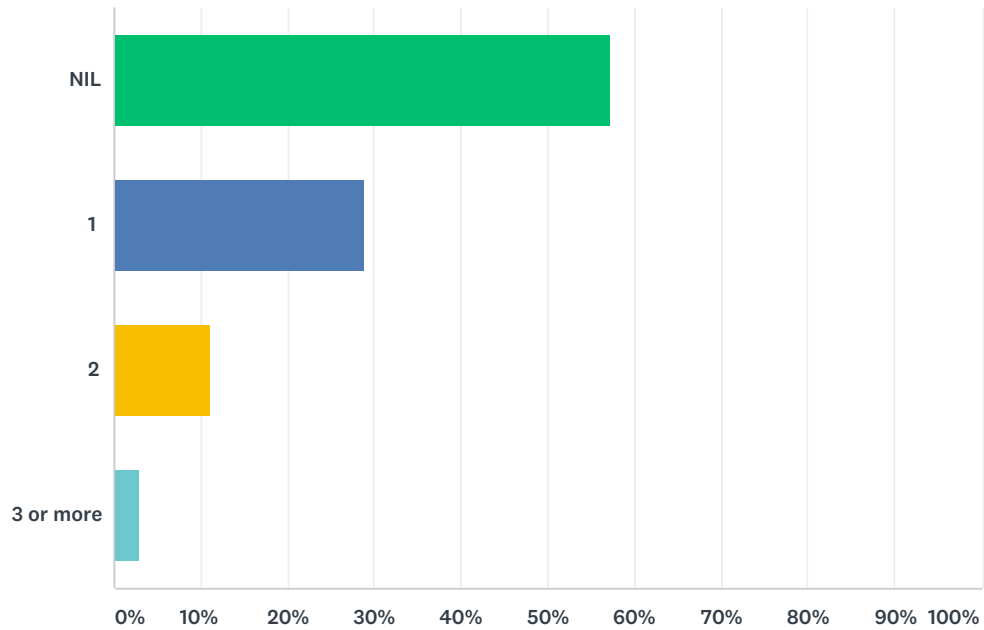

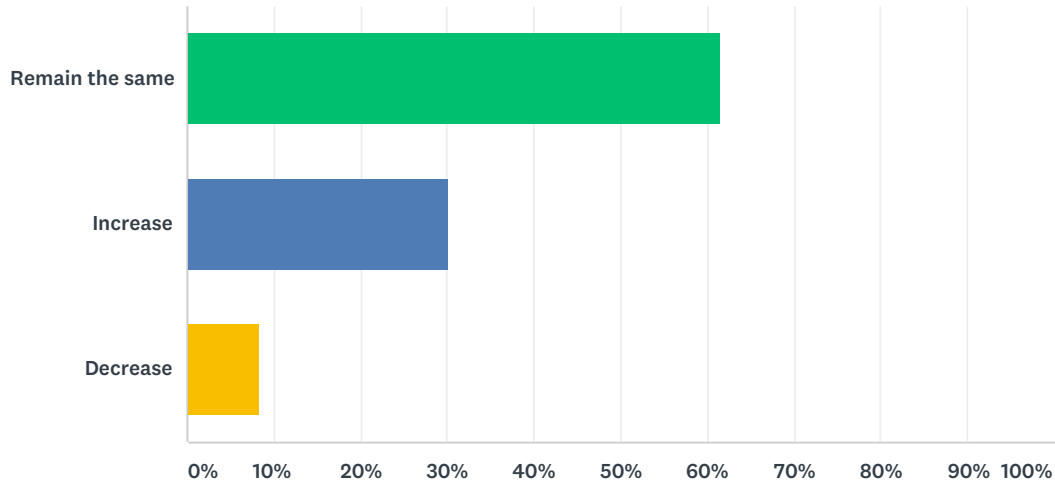

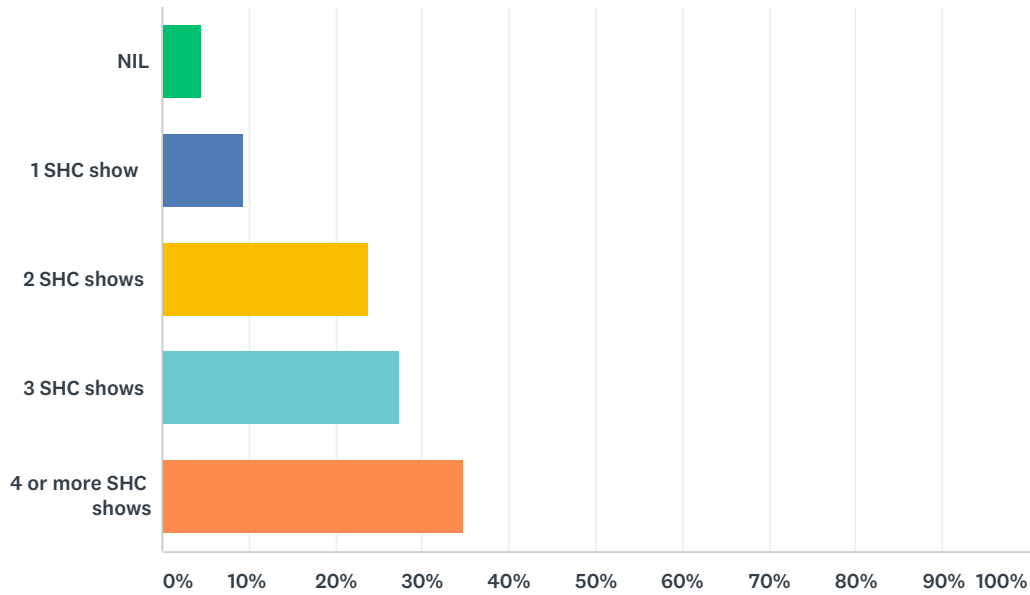

Q6 On average, how many Grand National qualifying shows hosted by the Show Horse Council would you attend in a 12 month period?

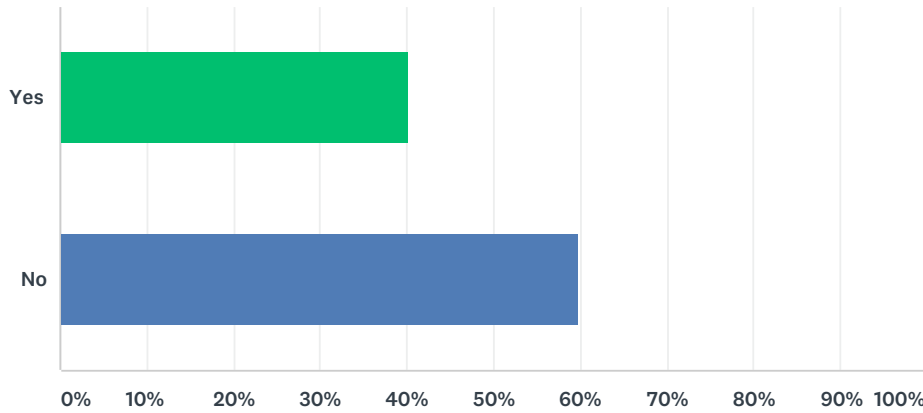

Q7 Do you travel interstate to compete at Grand National qualifying shows hosted by the Show Horse Council?

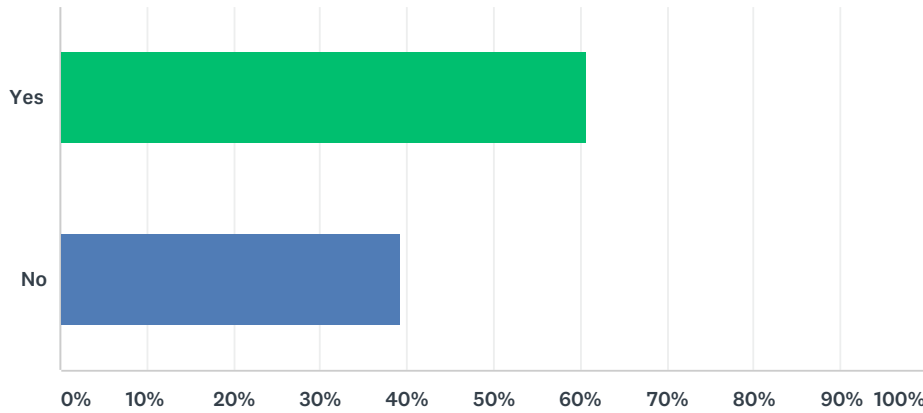

Q8 Do you travel interstate to compete at show horse competitions that are not affiliated with the Show Horse Council? Eg. Royal Shows

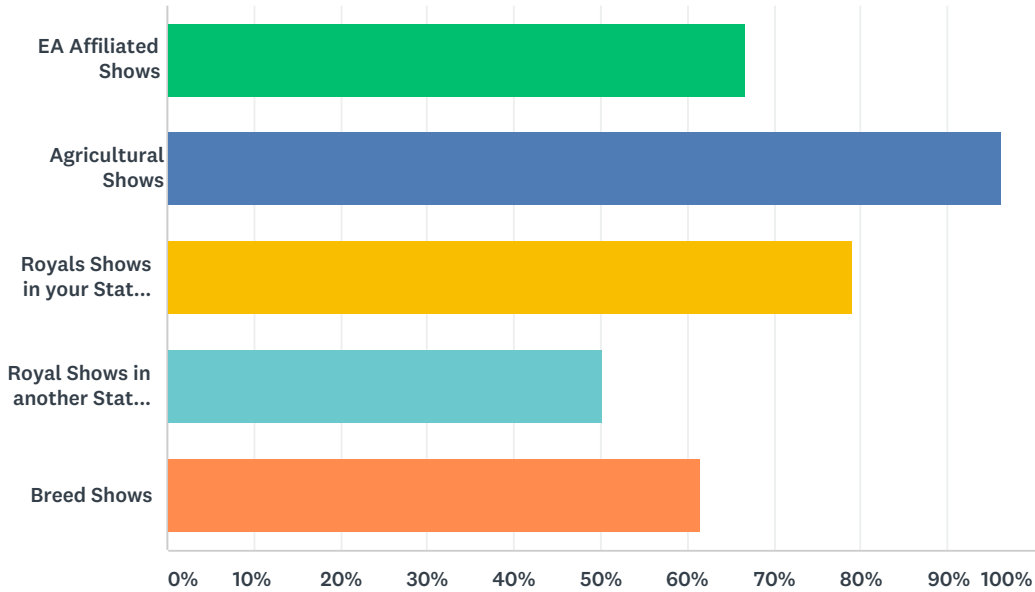

Q9 In addition to Show Horse Council hosted Grand National qualifying shows, what other Show Horse competitions do you compete at? (You may select more than one response)

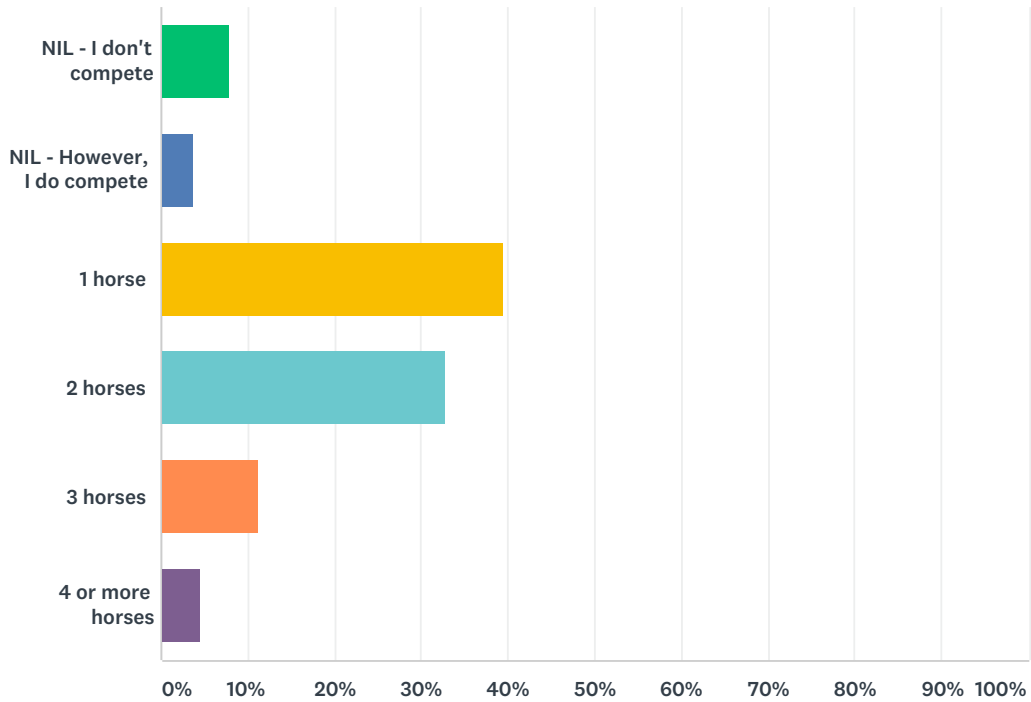

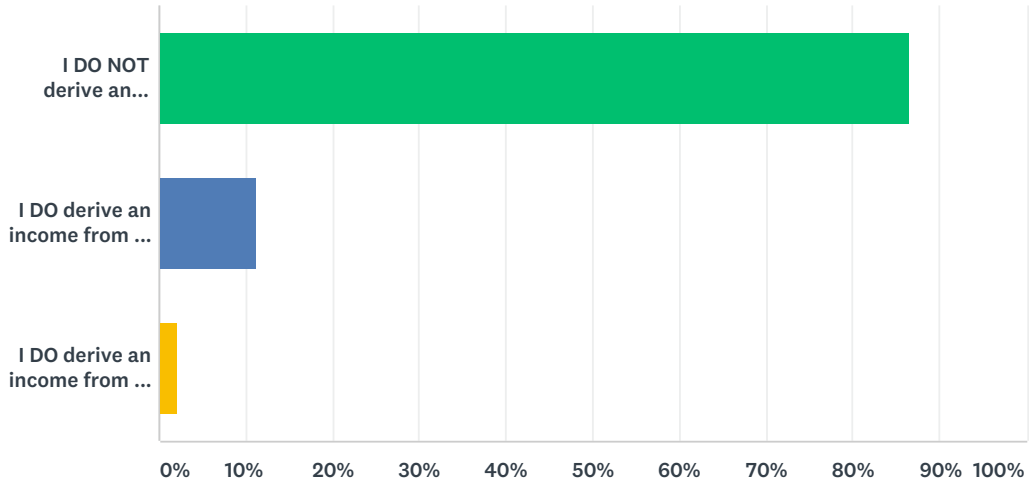

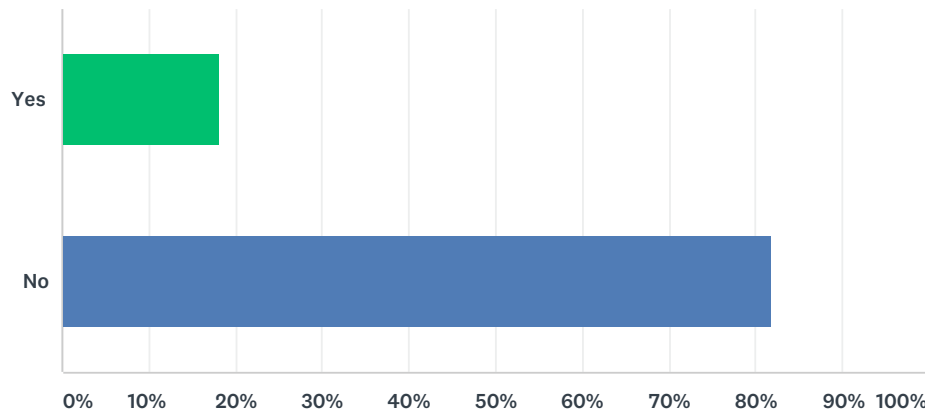

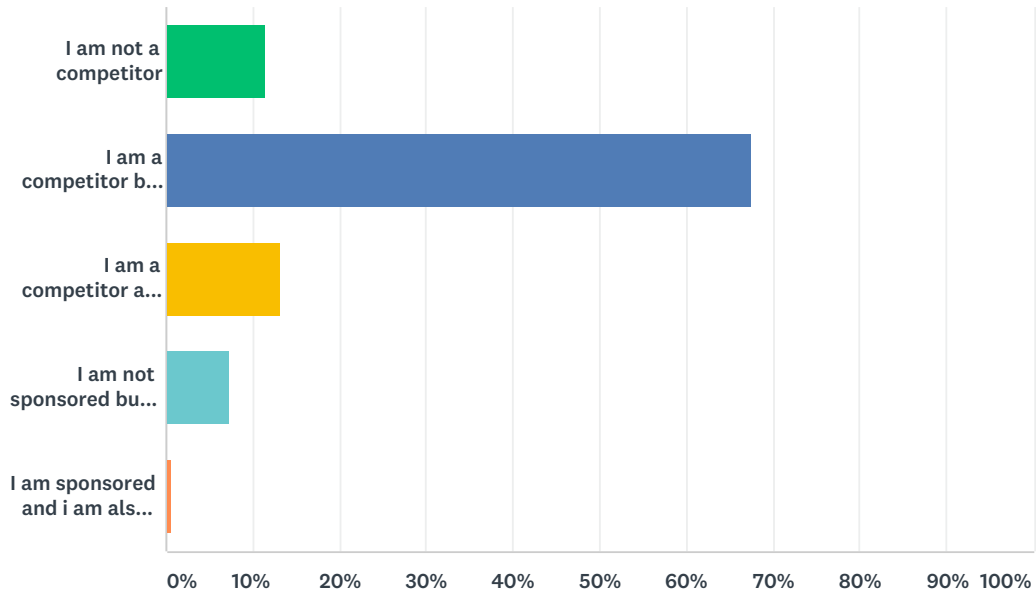

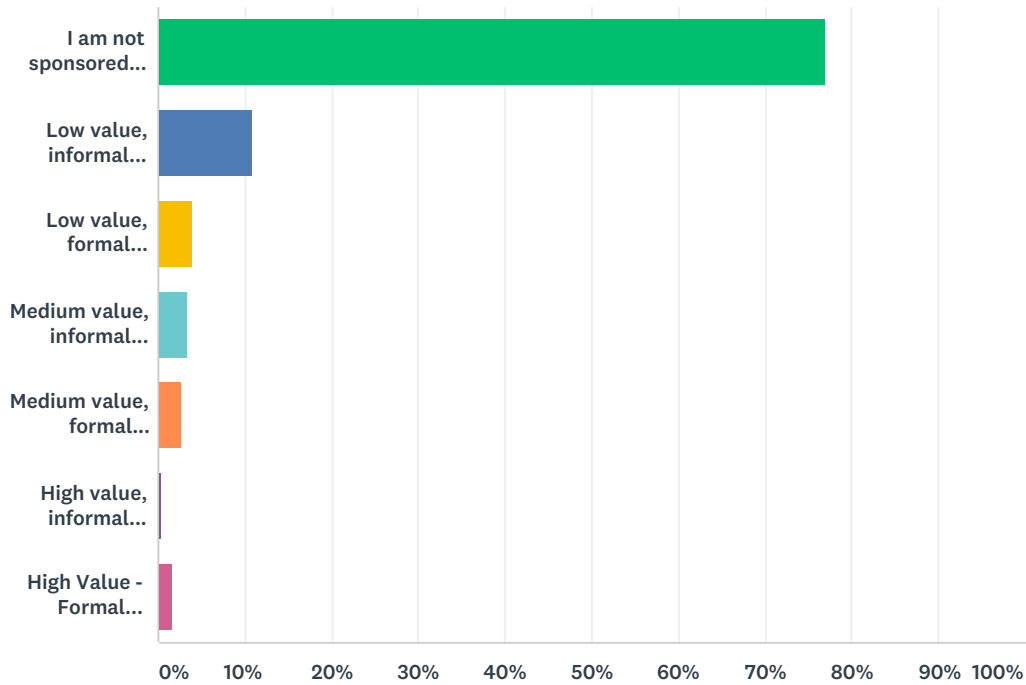

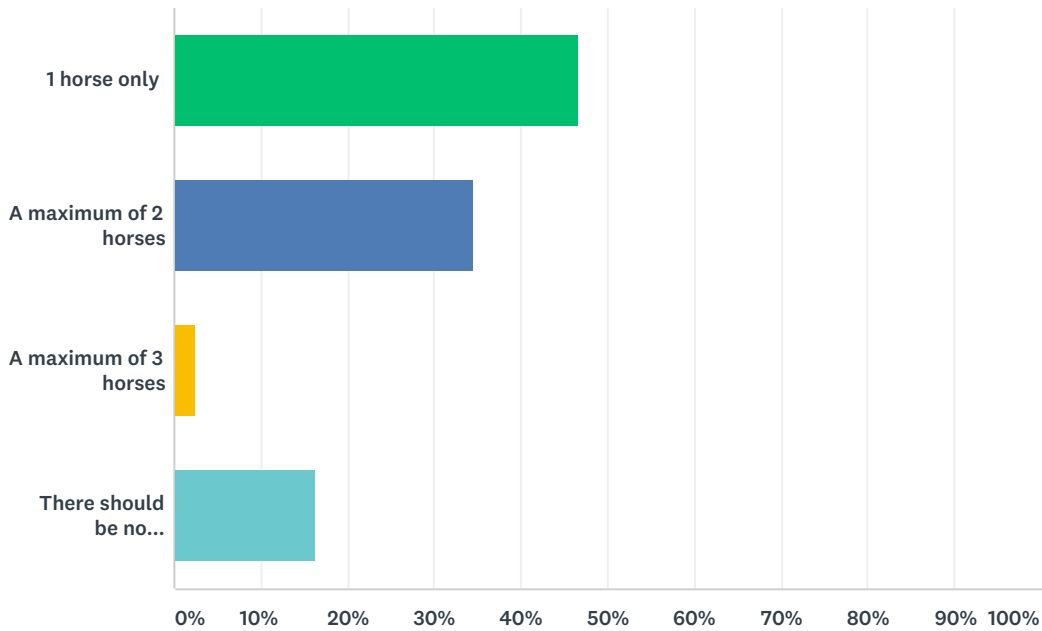

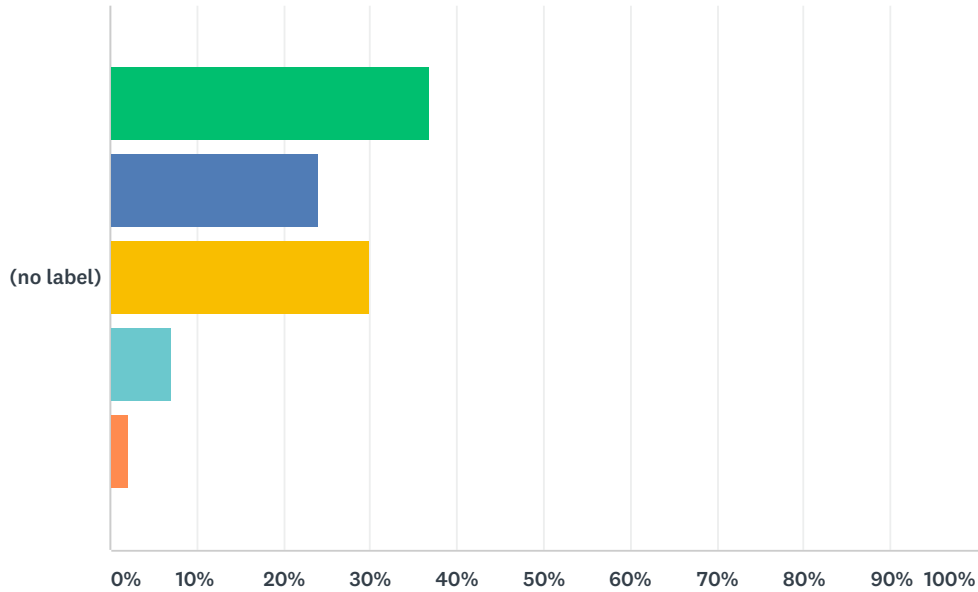

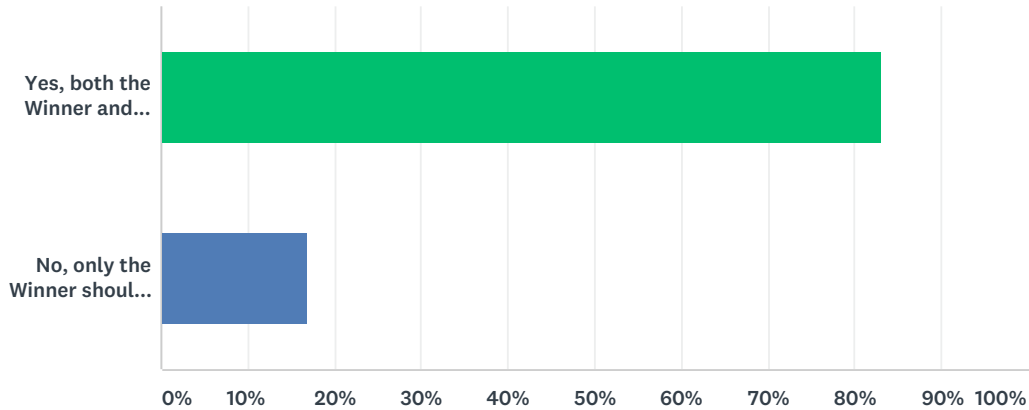

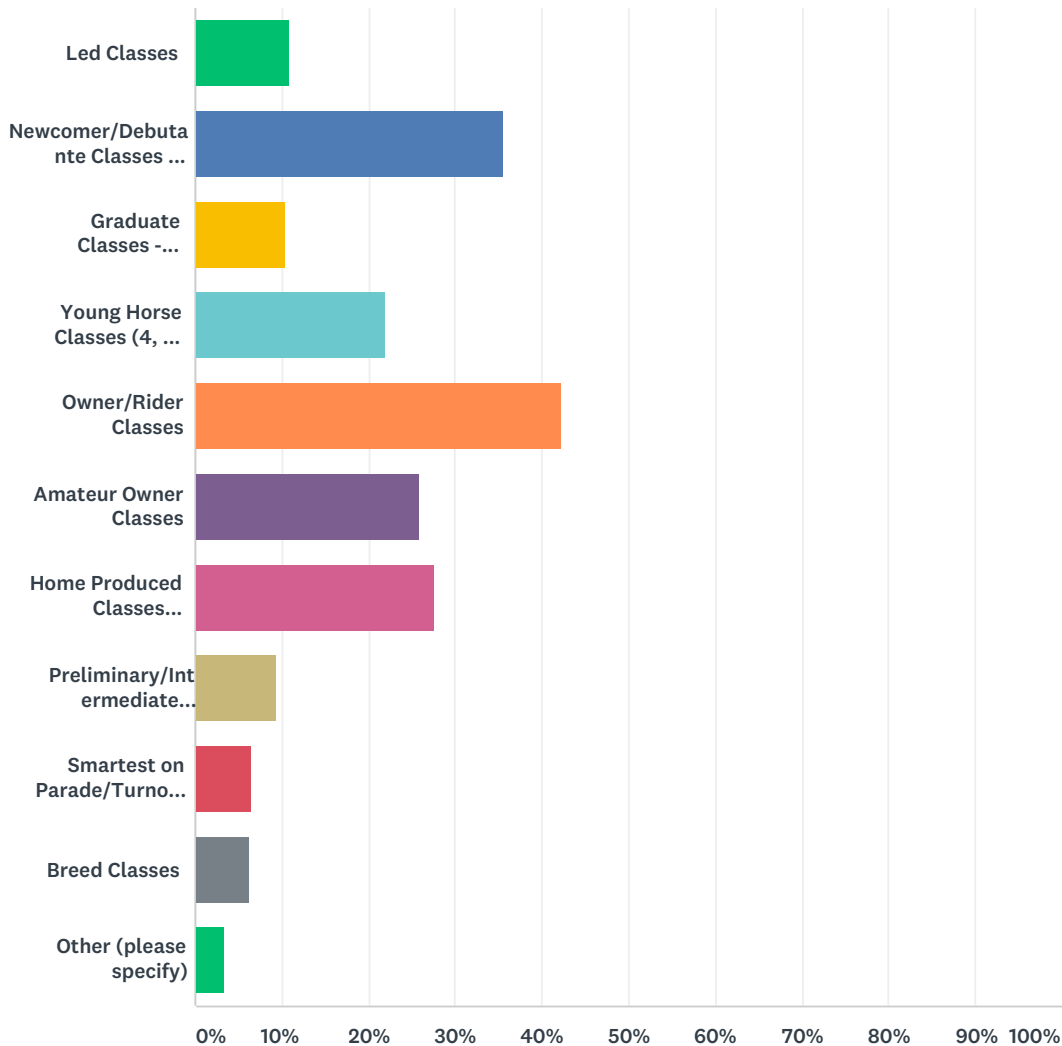

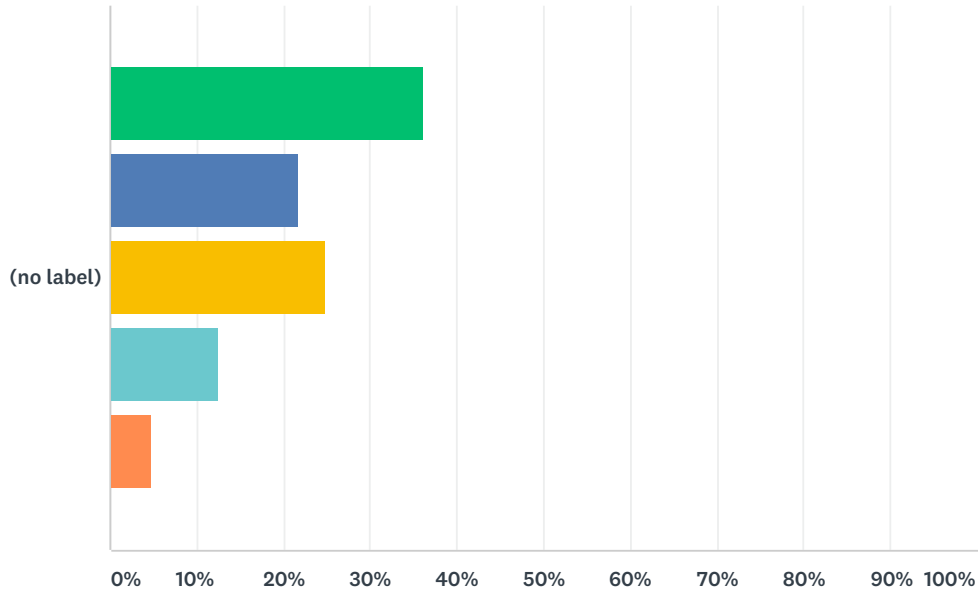

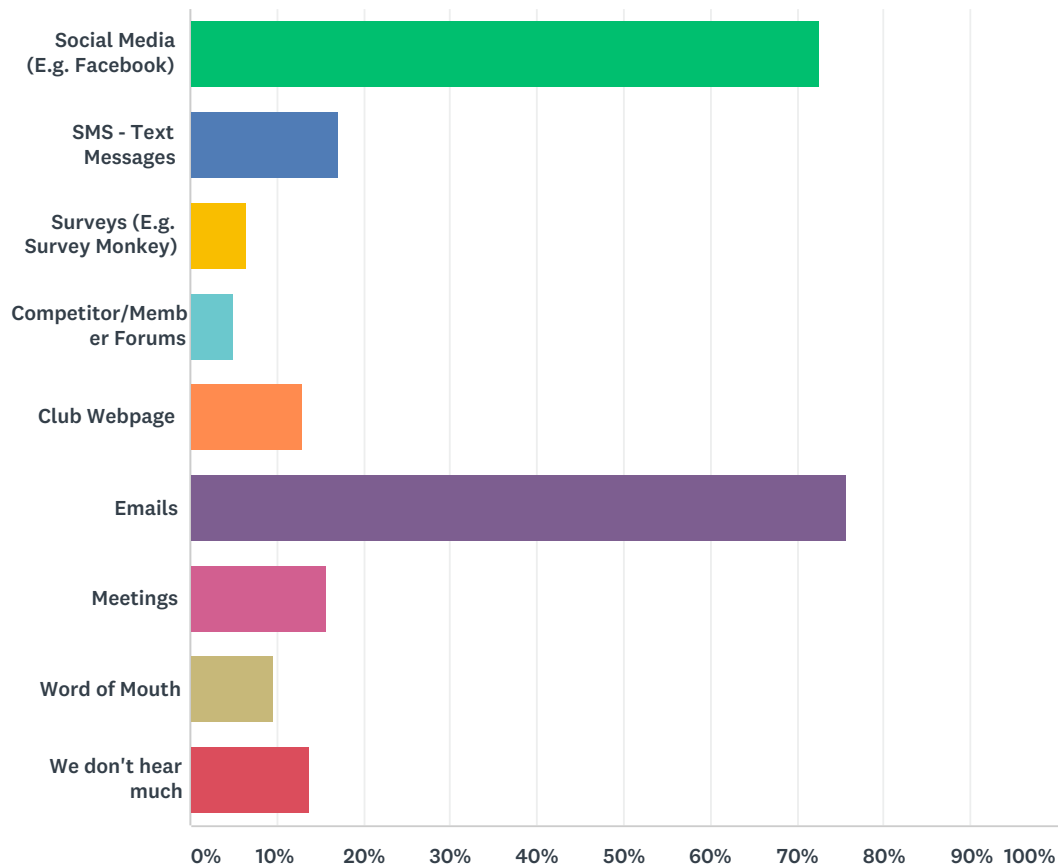

Q20 Currently, which methods of communication does your club use to communicate with you? (You may select more than one option)

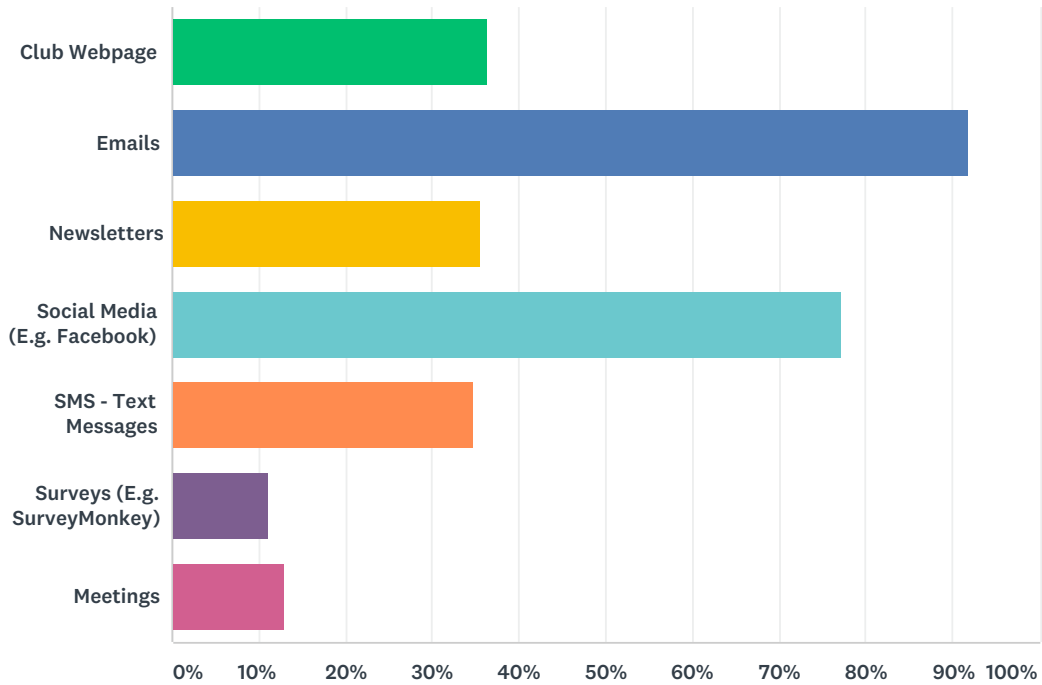

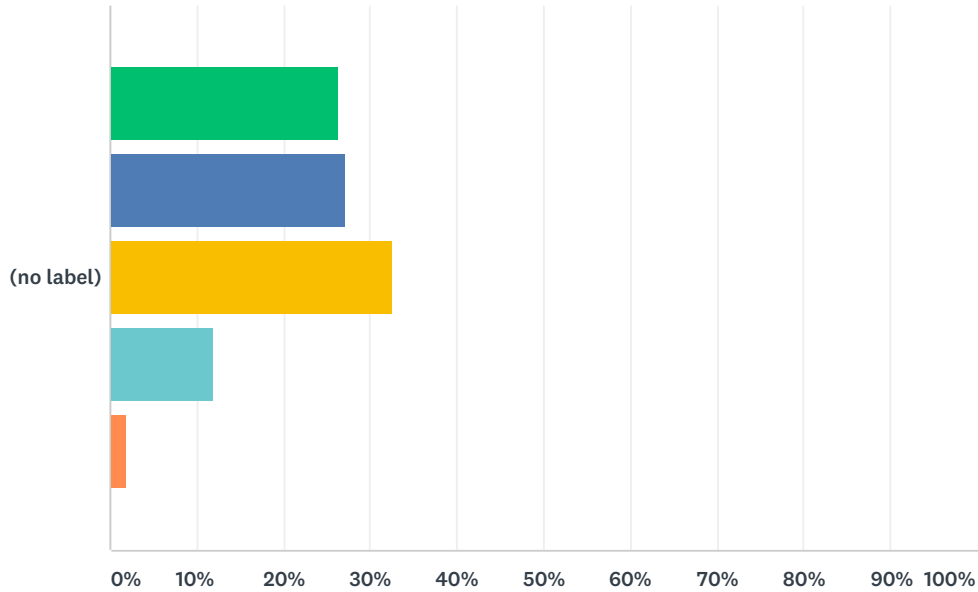

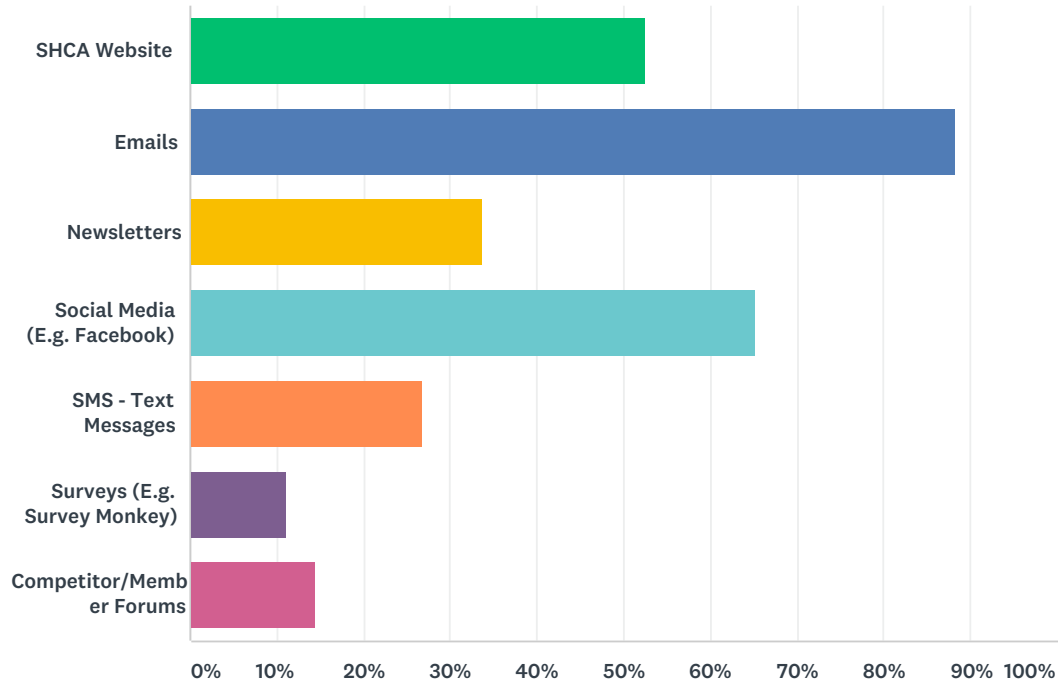

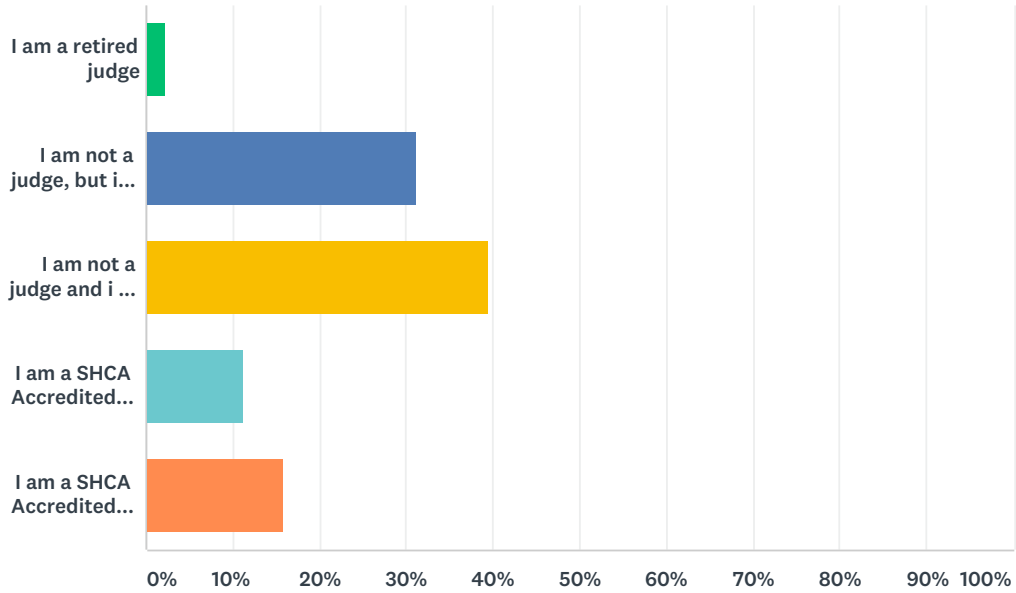

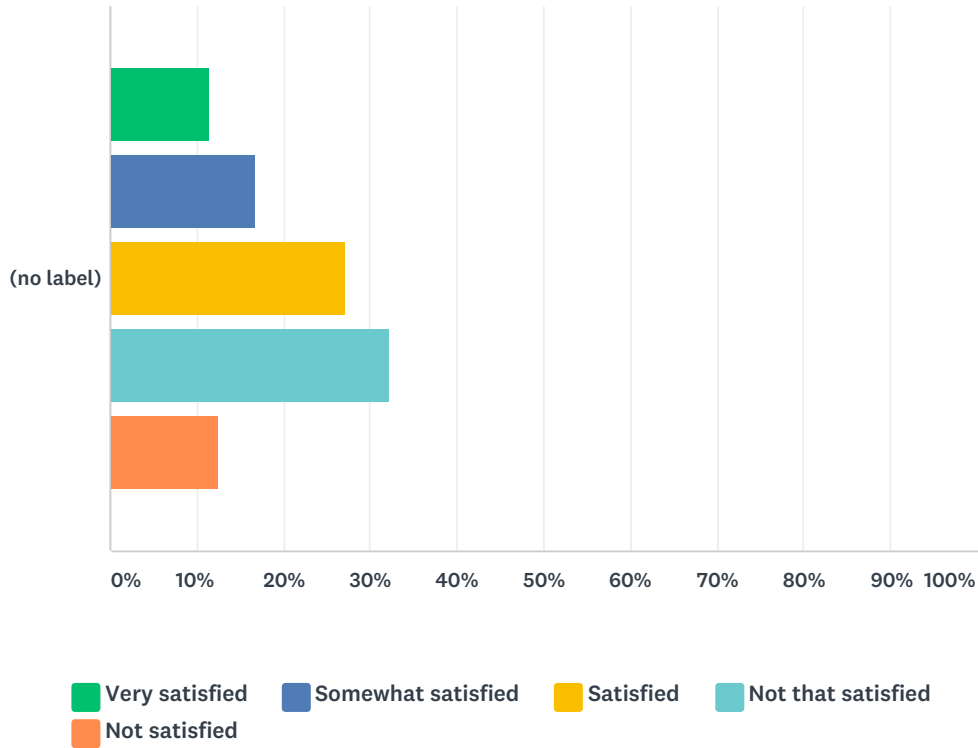

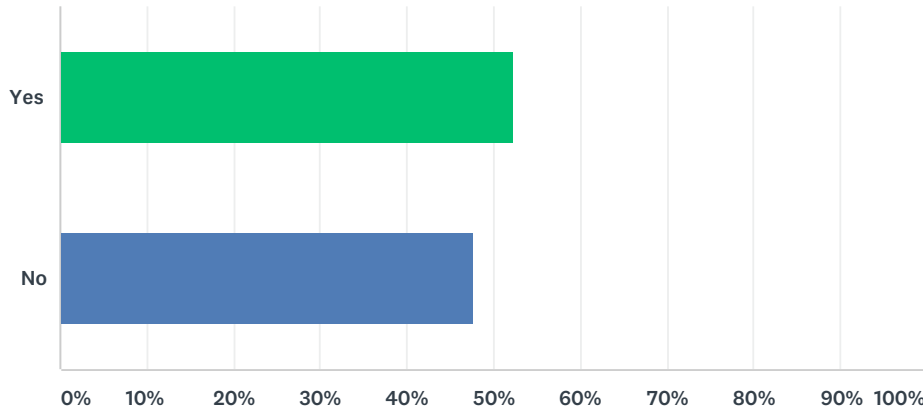

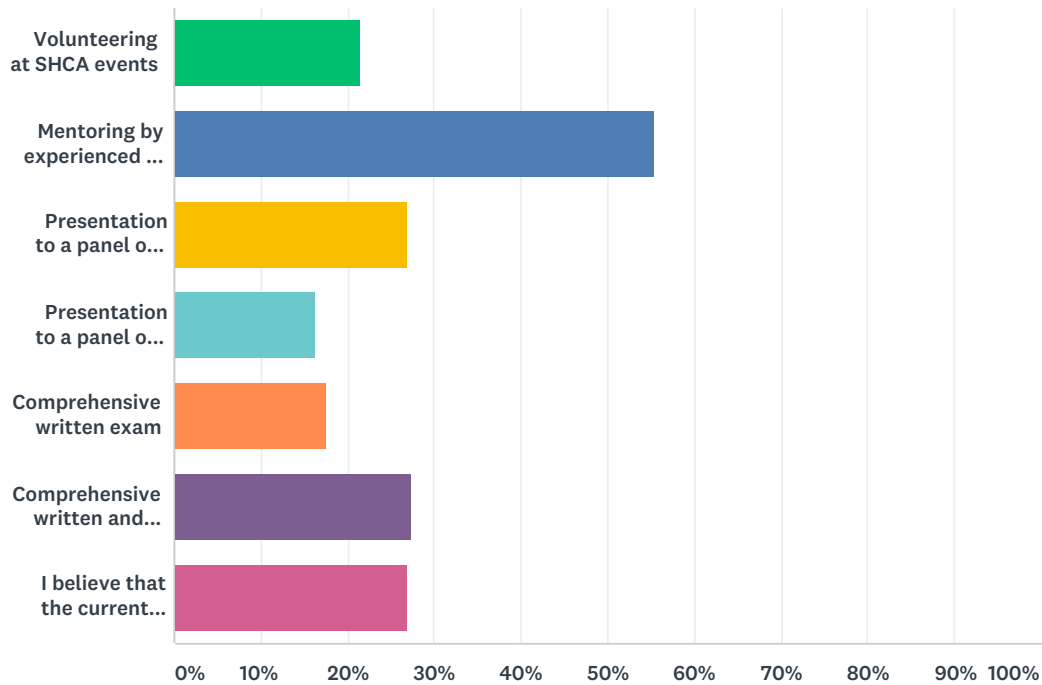

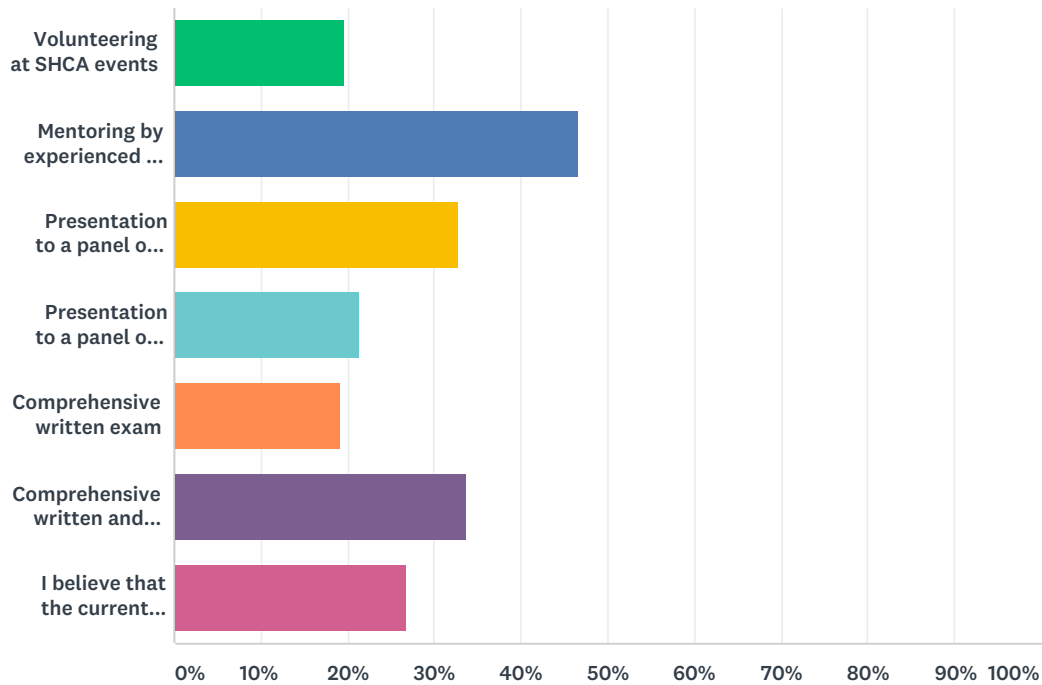

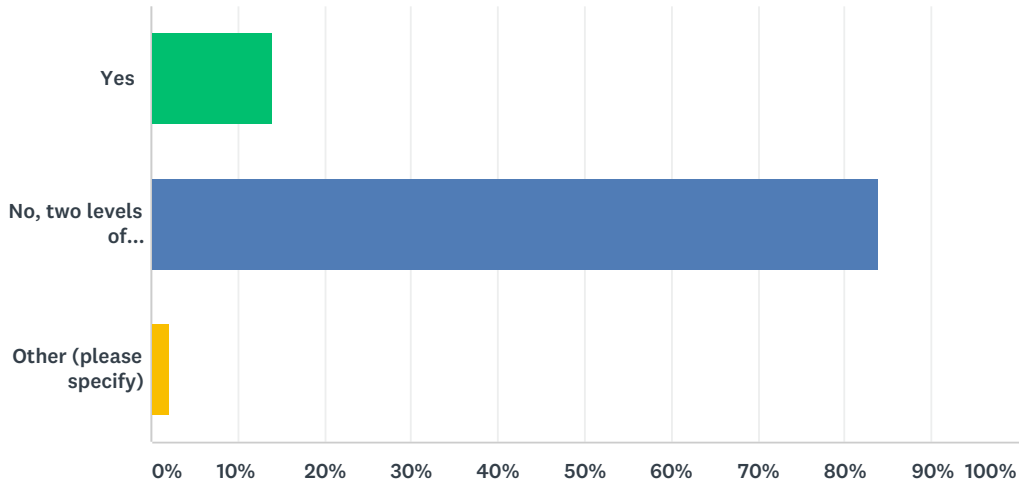

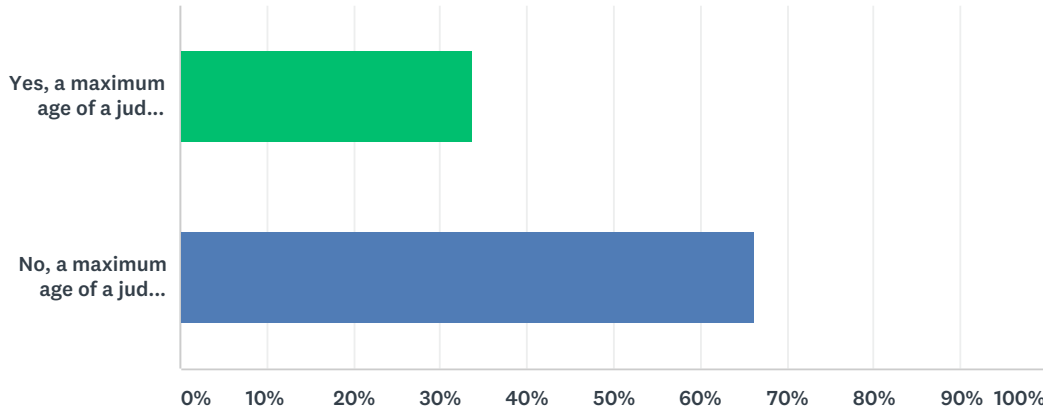

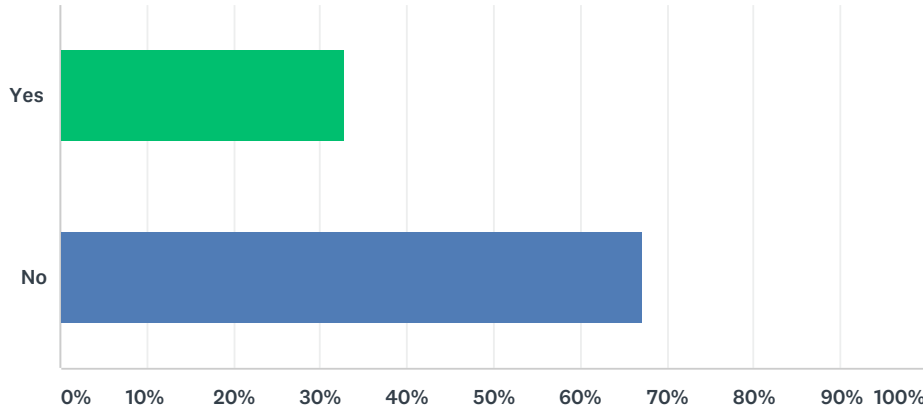

Q31 In the past 12 months, have you volunteered in any capacity at an event hosted by the Show Horse Council of Australasia or its Affiliates?

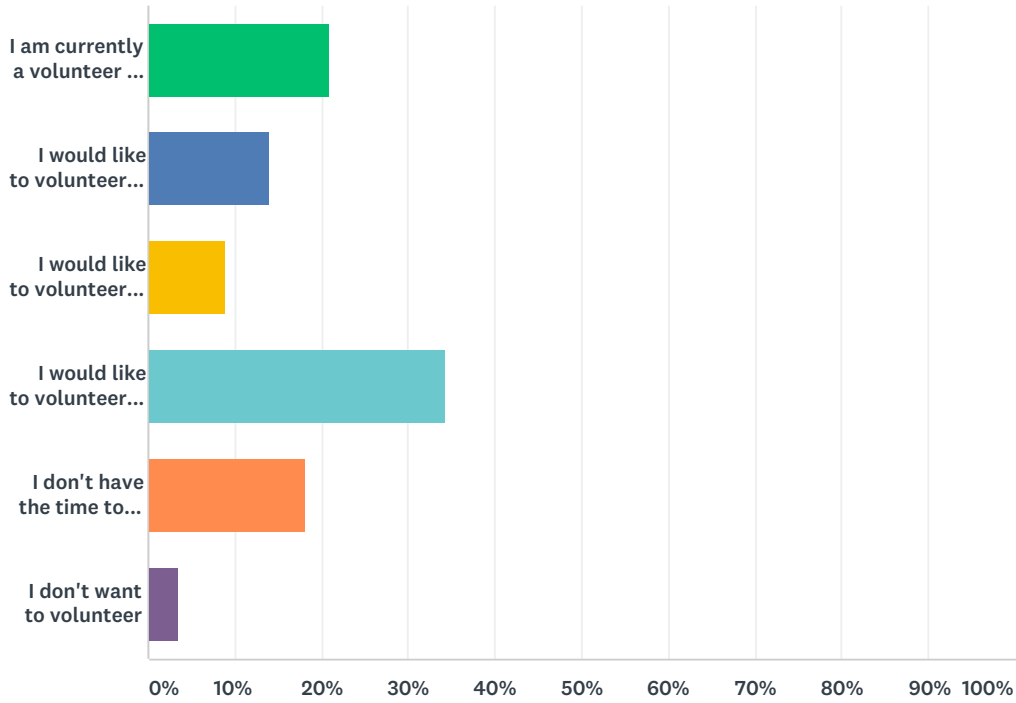

Q32 Research tells us that volunteering makes people happier and healthier. On the subject of volunteering for the Show Horse Council, which of the following best describes you?

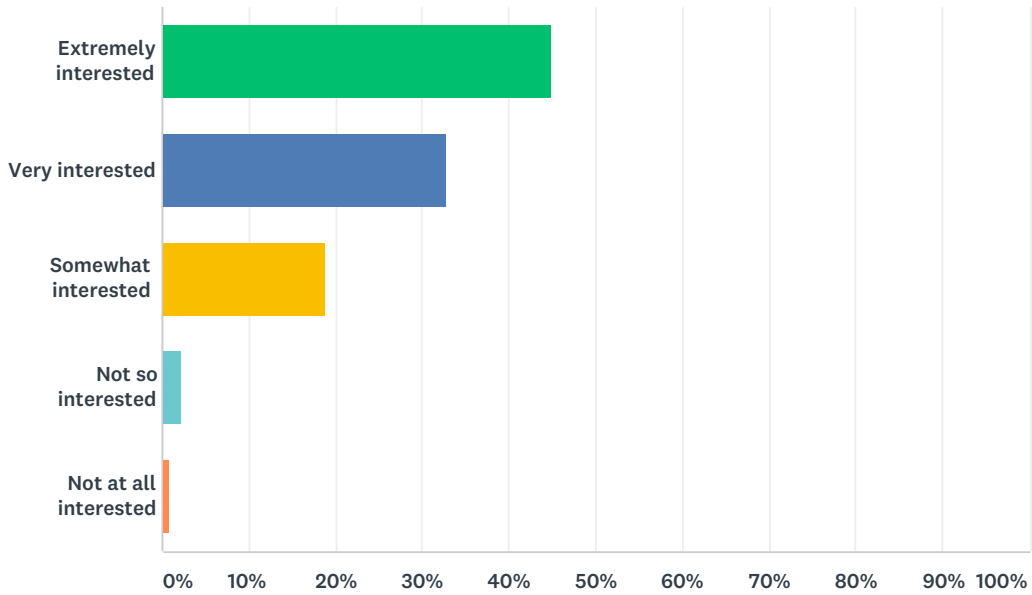
